The IFBB Professional League (IFBB Pro) has concluded its investigation into the complaint you submitted on January 6, 2026, wherein you alleged IFBB Pro committed “Clinical Fraud” and “Fraud in the Inducement” with respect to the 2025 Northwest Natural Pro.

Based upon this investigation, IFBB Pro respectfully denies that it has engaged in any sort of “Clinical Fraud” and/or “Fraud in the Inducement.” In your January 17, 2026 affidavit of fact, you state, “I personally observed the athlete utilize a personal, non-sterile ‘Shewee’ (female urination device) to provide her sample into the collection cup.” Furthermore, the onsite doping control official explicitly stated on both lab requisition forms that they did not observe the sample collection. This behavior exemplifies honesty, truthfulness, and transparency, which directly contradicts any sort of fraud.

IFBB Pro recognizes that the use of a personal urination device (PUD) may be contrary to generally accepted practice and has since updated its natural contest rules to prohibit the use of such devices.

IFBB Pro has thus invalidated the urinalysis results in the Women’s Physique division at the 2025 Northwest Natural Pro. IFBB Pro is also in the process of updating its sample collection protocol.

Regardless, IFBB Pro rules allow for urine, polygraph, *or* a combination of both testing methods. Since both athletes passed the polygraph examination and the results were not challenged, IFBB Pro considers these results valid, and therefore, the final placings in the Women’s Physique division shall remain unchanged from the 2025 Northwest Natural Pro.

IFBB Pro appreciates your attention to this matter and reiterates it has actively taken steps to prohibit PUDs and is in the process of updating its sample collection protocol.
